These are:

- **Caring** – young person places high value on helping people.
- **Equality and social justice** – young person places high value on equality and reducing hunger and poverty.
- **Integrity** – young person acts on convictions and stands up for his or her beliefs.
- **Honesty** – Young person tells the truth even when it is not easy
- **Responsibility** – Young person accepts and takes personal responsibility

The GOOD DEED AWARD PROGRAM further recognizes students who demonstrate outstanding caring and courage.

How it works:

The PTA Council GOOD DEED AWARD PROGRAM Committee will review the submitted Nominations. Designated award recipients and their schools will be notified.

Deadline for the Fall semester is January 19. Deadline for the Spring semester is April 21.
